- General race information
- 16/17 years old: Rules
  - Weapons fixed at maths. Not to be carried on their backs
  - Be aware of standing shootings: Do not at any time point the gun sideways. Up or towards target is correct.

#### Weapon security

- Norwegian rules are strict compared to some foreign countries.
- Trigger control from 09.00 at the garage. Min limit: 500grams
- Weapon control after zeroing for juniors. At the end of the shooting range (with target no. 1).
  - It is the athletes own responsibility that they are crossed out on the list. Tell them to check! Team captain should aslso check after zeroing finish.

  - Not able to construct the right lenghts for 2,5 km, so we use only 1.5, 2.0 and 3.0 km.
  - We will open a way through the finish-area when zeroing.







  100m Penalty loop
- 16/17 yrs (\*) 6 km (2km + 2km + 2km) prone-standing 150m Penalty loop
- 18/19 yrs 6 km (2km + 2km + 2km) prone-standing 150m Penalty loop
- 20/21 yrs 7 km (2km + 2km + 3km) prone-standing 150m Penalty loop















- MENS SPRINT
- 14/15 yrs (\*) 5 km (1,5km + 1,5km + 2km) prone-prone 100m Penalty loop
- 16/17 yrs (\*) 7 km (2km + 2km + 3km) prone-standing 150m Penalty loop
- 18/19 yrs 7 km (2km + 2km + 3km) prone-standing 150m Penalty loop

- 20/21 yrs 10 km (2km+2km+2km+2km) prone-prone-standing-standing 150m Penalty loop















- Mens Mass Start
- 14/15 yrs (\*) 5 km (1,5km + 1,5km + 2km) prone-prone 100m Penalty loop
  - 16/17 yrs (\*) 10 km (2km+2km+2km+2km) prone-prone-standing-standing 150m Penalty loop
- 18/19 yrs 10 km (2km+2km+2km+2km) prone-prone-standingstanding – 150mPenalty loop
- 20/21 yrs 12 km (3km+2km+2km+2km+3km) prone-prone-standingstanding – 150m Penalty loop













#### Technical Briefing

- EMIT timing system
